THE BLOOD COVENANT, PART 7 THE FINAL EXCHANGE

1 Corinthians 15:50-57

The Body of Christ will get new bodies from Christ.

Anticipate the great tragedy. (15:50)

⁵⁰ I declare to you, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.

You will be dead!

Anticipate the great mystery. (15:51-53)

⁵¹ Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed— ⁵² in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. ⁵³ For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality.

You will be different!

Anticipate the great victory. (15:54-55)

⁵⁴ When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory." ⁵⁵"Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?"

You will be dancing!

Anticipate the great doxology. (15:56-57)

⁵⁶ The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. ⁵⁷ But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

You will be declaring!
